The link is not a fund raising organisation more of a friendship. Having said that some churches have identified specific needs and helped raise funds for school toilets etc.

As part of the celebrations The Uganda Fellowship Choir will be visiting Swindon on Saturday October 5th at St. Michael and All Angels Church, Highworth. Look out for more details nearer the day.

Some of you may remember them as the Uganda Youth Fellowship Choir who visited us in May 2012 and were promoted as Uganda Fire.
