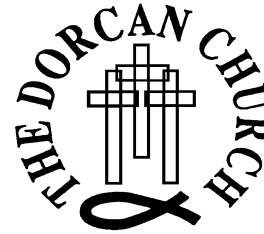
We need to know in the next two weeks if we are to have a chance of booking a coach.
