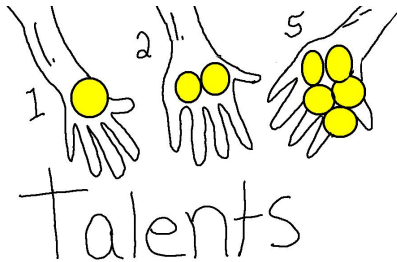

In the booklet we can read about Gods work around the world. Let's allow Gods Word to help us to draw closer to him and to know him as our Heavenly Father.

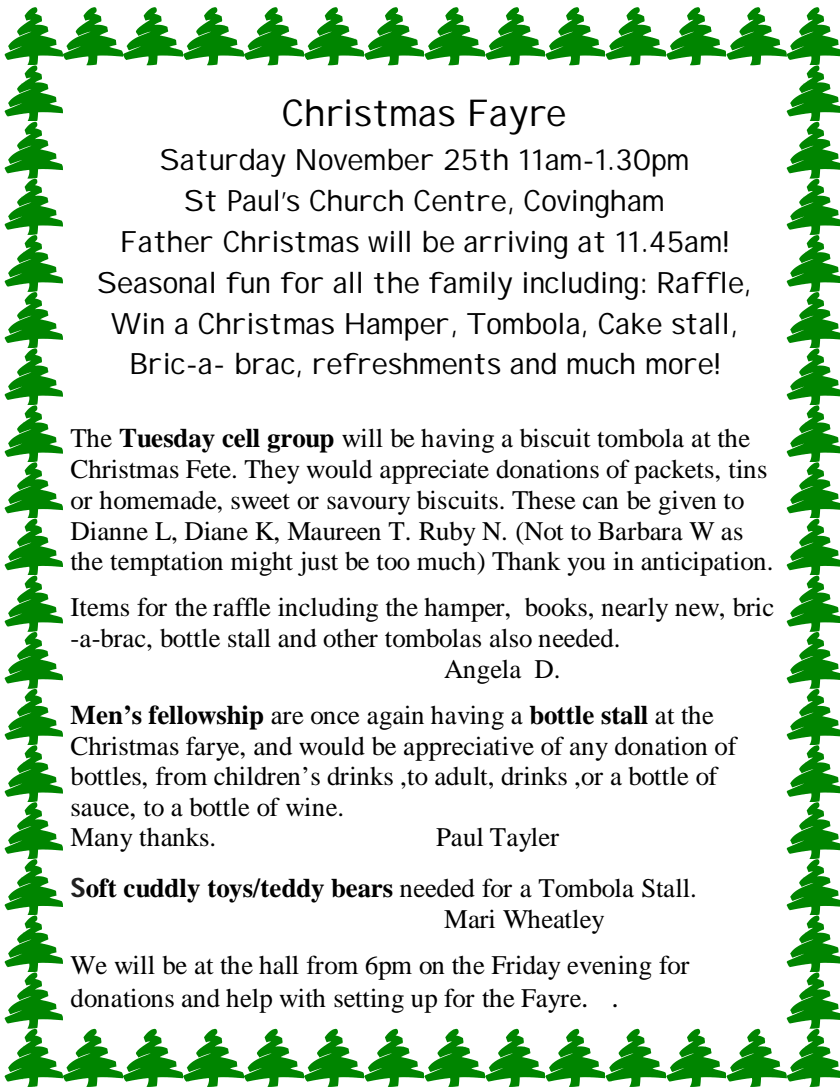
