Also, to save trees and paper, if you would like to receive the magazine by email, then send your email address to Stuart.

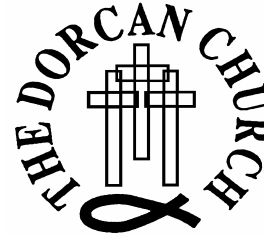
