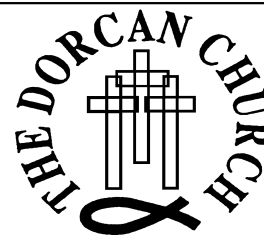

Treatment of St. Paul's Church Floor - Appeal for Volunteers

Following the favourable comments concerning the Hall floor, people have asked when the Church floor can be treated. We propose to strip and re-seal the church floor during Half-term week, beginning on Sunday 24th October. We intend to clear and prepare the area on the Sunday evening. We then intend to start each day at 7.30am. The various tasks and treatments are of different durations.
