Swindon Churches Together School Prayer Event

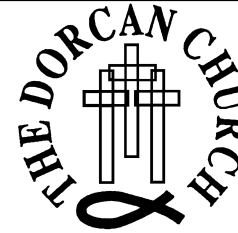
